
JURISDICTIONAL DISCOVERY AND BRIEFING SCHEDULE

The Court enters the following schedule for jurisdictional discovery and motion briefing pursuant to the agreement of the PLC and Defendants Mead Johnson & Company, LLC and Mead Johnson Nutrition Company (collectively, “Mead Johnson” and altogether, “the Parties”):

1. Mead Johnson shall have 30 days from the entry of the Electronically Stored Information (“ESI”) Order to file any motions to dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction, improper venue, or *forum non conveniens*;
2. The Parties shall have 65 days from the entry of the ESI Order to conduct jurisdictional discovery;
3. Plaintiffs shall have 75 days from the entry of the ESI Order to file any oppositions to Mead Johnson’s motions; and,
4. Mead Johnson shall have 90 days from the entry of the ESI Order to file any replies in further support of its motions.
